



From May 2019, the digital route service for ships arriving and departing Norwegian ports will be available from Sandefjord in the southeast to Haugesund in the southwest – in addition to already available routes for the Oslofjord, launched in 2018.

The service provides quality-assured routes and waypoints to commercial vessels, free of charge.

Important route information is included, such as local regulations for the voyage, ports and quays, and sailing distances.

The digital route service facilitates automatic and efficient distribution of important and useful route information to support safe and efficient navigation.

Benefits for commercial vessels

Automatic and efficient exchange of route information:

- Improves Bridge Resource Management (BRM).

Recommended routes and route information can be downloaded to bridge systems in RTZ 1.0 format.

The digital route service will be available on the entire Norwegian coast in 2020.
